- 1) Speech & Language (Articulation, Receptive, Expressive)
- 2) Cognitive Skills (Attention & Memory, Academics)
- 3) Social/Emotional (Behavioral, Social Interaction)
- 4) Adaptive (Self Help Skills)
- 5) Motor (Physical and Occupational)
- 6) Vision & Hearing
